2. Membership: Must be a Full Member of ASI with minimum 5 years

3. He should have attended at least 3 Annual conferences of ASI in the preceding 5 years

4. Marks will be awarded for presentation of papers (Evidence to be produced)

State level - 10 marks National level - 15 marks International level - 20 marks

5. Marks will be awarded for publications (Evidence to be produced)

State level - 10 marks National level - 15 marks International level - 20 marks

6. Marks will be awarded for participation in CME (Evidence to be produced)

State level - 10 marks National level - 15 marks International level - 20 marks

7. Marks will be awarded for attending Conference (Evidence to be produced)

State level - 10 marks National level - 15 marks International level - 20 marks

8. Marks will be awarded for attending Workshop & for other merits: (Evidence to be produced)

State level - 10 marks National level - 15 marks International level - 20 marks

- 9. The applicants should apply for the award through their State Chapters only. The State Chapter Committee should select one application and send it to the Central Office, on or **before** 15th October.
- 10. Selection Committee will be headed by the President, Vice President, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer and 3 or 4 EC members also representing various parts of the country. President will have extra voting rights if there is any tie in selection.
- 11. Candidate once awarded will not be awarded for another time.
- 12. Candidate must be present to receive the award during ASICON and if he is not able to attend the conference and receive the award, the respective State Chapter's Chairman or Secretary should inform the Central Office the reason for his absence.
- 13. A cheque for Rs.50, 000/- and a certificate will be awarded during the Annual Conference of the ASI to the winner of the award.

NOTE: Application received for a particular year will be considered only for that year and will not be considered for subsequent year.
