• This year the association is inviting applications for Prof. Sarat Chandra Travelling Fellowship, 2019.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The fellowship is meant to be utilized only within our country. The fellowship is awarded only to a lifetime member of IAES. The applicant should be below the age of 45 years as on 15th June, 2019. A member can apply for only one Travelling Fellowship any one year. The Fellowship will have to be availed in the same year and will not be allowed to be carried forward for the subsequent years. The selected candidate will attend IAESCON of that year, for updating his knowledge. Documents to be sent must include:
 - (i) Duly filled application form for the fellowship in the enclosed format.
 - (ii) An application stating what benefits the applicant expects from the fellowship.
 - (iii) Curriculum Vitae of the applicant.

- (iv) 2 recommendations from senior surgeons and one from the Head of the department (optional).
- One hard copy each of all the required documents, is to be sent by post to the Hon. Secretary, Indian Association of Endocrine Surgeons of India, on or before 15th July 2019. Applications will be scrutinized by a committee appointed by the President for the said purpose and the decision of the committee will be final. On completion of the fellowship, the candidate must send a detailed report. A Certificate and an Award Cheque of ₹10,000/- will be given to the fellow during the Annual Conference of IAESCON.

INDORE

Indore is the largest city in Madhya Pradesh and together with its satellite towns of Pithampur and Dewas, is one of the fastest growing economic regions of India. The history of Indore is inseparable from the history of the Holkar State. Today, Indore is a perfect mélange of the old and the new, where the old heritage structures co-exist with the modern multi-storey buildings.





'NIALLU

Ujjain is known as the city of temples and is important in terms of religious beliefs. The city is also recognized as an important part of the Indian History. Ujjain is renowned for one of the 12 Jyotirlings - The Mahakaleshwar Temple.



Mandu is a celebration in stone; of life, love and joy. The whole city is a tribute to the bond shared between the poet-prince Baz Bahadur and his beautiful consort, Rani Roopmati.



MAHESHWAR

Maheshwar's temples and mighty fort-complex stand in quiet beauty, mirrored in the river Narmada below. Today, Maheshwar is also known for its distinctive and exquisitively handwoven sarees called 'Maheshwari' sarees.



Omkareshwar, one of the 12 Jyotirlings, situated on river Narmada - the sacred island, shaped like the holiest of all Hindu symbols, 'Om', draws uncountable pilgrims every year.







TOURIST ATTRACTIONS AROUND MADHYA PRADESH

KHAJURAHO

In the temple architecture of India, the Khajuraho complex remains unique. One thousand years ago, under the generous and artistic patronage of the Chandela Rajput kings of Central India, 85 temples, magnificent in form and richly carved, came up on one site, near the village of Khajuraho. Today, of the original 85, only 22 have survived the ravages of time; which remains as a collective paean to life, to joy and to creativity; to the ultimate fusion of man with his creator.



KANHA

Kanha's Sal and Bamboo forests, rolling grasslands and meandering streams stretch over 940 sq. km in a dramatic natural splendour; which form the core of the Kanha Tiger Reserve created in 1974 under Project Tiger.



ORCHHA

Orchha was founded in the 16th century by the Bundela Rajput chieftain, Rudra Pratap, who chose this stretch of land along the Betwa river as an ideal site for his capital. From here the view of the stunning temple spires and cenotaphs is spectacular.



SANCHI

The Buddhist Vihara, famous for its Great Stupa, is located at Sanchi Town in Raisen District of the state of Madhya Pradesh, India.



BHEDAGHAT

Soaring in a glittering magnificence, the Marble Rocks at Bhedaghat rise to a hundred feet on either side of the mighty Narmada. These tall mountains are known to magically change shapes as you sail along the river. A little distance away, the calm Narmada throws in a beautiful surprise as it plunges in an impressive waterfall known as Dhuandhar.
