Dr. Kailash Mohapatra took over as President and Dr. Sabaretnam.M as Honorary Secretary during our Annual Conference in September 2021 conducted virtually. The IAES Sectional program at ASI Annual Conference also conducted virtually was well attended where 50 faculty members of IAES participated and delivered lectures. In view of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Executive committee meeting was held virtually three times.

The website of our Chapter has been updated and is functioning effectively. The Audited Statement of account has already been submitted to the Association of Surgeons of India.

Our Section members have promoted the association by enrolling twelve new members to IAES. Journal of IAES "Indian Journal of Endocrine Surgery and Research" has now three issues released

Further to the directive of ASI and as decided by the Executive Committee meeting of IAES, the 22nd st Annual Conference of IAES was conducted on a Physical mode.

Report- 23rd National conference of IAES- IAESCON 2022, 15,16th and 17th September 2022, CMC Vellore

The 23rd National conference of the Indian Association of Endocrine Surgeons was conducted at Christian Medical College, Vellore at the Bagayam Campus on 16th and 17th September 2022. This two-day conference was preceded by a hands-on pre-conference workshop on 15th September 2022. The pre-conference workshop was attended by more than 40 delegates and was conducted by faculty from CMC Vellore and invited faculty. The morning session of the pre-conference workshop had interactive lectures from the departments of Radiology, Endocrinology and Nuclear Medicine on topics pertinent to the endocrine surgeons and give an insight on recent advances related to their specialities.

This was followed by a workshop with the focus on surgeon performed ultrasound, ultrasound guided fine needle aspiration cytology (FNAC), live cytology staining and demonstration, anatomy using plastinated head and neck models and hands-on ultrasound guided FNAC and vacuum assisted biopsy on tissue specimens. The response to this session was very good and

all the delegates lauded the theory to practical transition experience that this session provided.

The afternoon session by senior retired faculty started with talks from Dr. Aravindan Nair, Dr. Anurag Srivastav and Dr. Ranil Fernando in the 'Care to Share' session who talked about their career experience sharing pearls of wisdom. The highlight of the day was the cadaveric dissection in anatomy dissection hall for neck anatomy, transoral mental nerve anatomy and retroperitoneal adrenalectomy access which drew a huge response and was appreciapted by everyone who attended. This was followed by a session on operative videos from experts and case based discussion for under-grauate students who presented 2 cases and had a exam oriented discussion for these cases.

The 1st day of the National conference of IAESCON 2022 started with blessings from Padmashree Prof S Vittal- founding president of IAES. There were a series of interesting case based discussions presented by budding endocrine surgeons and opinions from seniors were sought. 'What is New' in the field of endocrine surgery was discussed in the next session followed by orations from eminent faculty. The Prof. S Vittal Oration"Parathyroid detection by infrared flurorescence" was deliverd by Dr. Frederic Triponez, Prof and Head, Dept. of Thoracic and Endocrine Surgery, University Hospital, Geneva via a recorded presentation and he was present live online to interact with the delegates. The KD Verma Oration on was delivered by Dr. Deepak Abraham, Prof of Endocrine Surgery, CMC Vellore and he spoke on 'Pracitising the art and science of medicne as a calling'. The Presidential oration "Trends in Endocrine Surgery" was given by Dr. Kailash Mohapatra, Prof of Surgery, SCB Medical Collage Cuttack and current President of Indian Association of Endocrine Surgeons.

The AJ Benson Best Poster competition had 14 entries and was intensely contested with high quality research being presented, the winner adjudged as (**Name of winner)

The innovate IAESCON Chennai 2009 quiz hosted by IAES secretary Dr. Sabaretnam was very informative and brought a cheer and smile to all. The quiz winners were Dr. Antarip Bhattacharya and Dr. Aadarsh Raghavan.

Prof. Jothi Ramalingam Best Paper award saw 6 papers of high quality being presented and intensily discussed. The final winner was adjudged as Dr. Rizhin Sooraj from KGMU, Lucknow.

The panel discussion on safe thyroid surgery had experienced surgeons from different parts of India sharing their experiences and tips and tricks they have learnt in performing safe total thyroidectomy. Prof James Lee from the Monash University, Melbourne and Dr.KithsiriSenanayake from SriLanka spoke on the Evolution of thyroid surgery and Normocalcemic hyperparathyroidism respectively in the special plenary lectures, both being present via zoom to answer questions from the delegates.

The inaugural function of IAESCON 2022 was graced by Dr. Kenny David, Associate Director CMC, Vellore, Dr. Prasad Mathew, Medical Superintendent, CMC Vellore, Dr. Solomon Satish Kumar, Principal, CMC Vellore, Dr. KailashMohapatra, Hon President, IAES, Dr. M. Sabaretnam, Hon. Secretary, IAES, Dr. MJ Paul, Organizing Chairman and Dr. Shawn Thomas, Organizing Secretary, IAESCON 2022. The inaugural function witnessed the release of the IAES textbook
