The programme was kick started on Wednesday, July 5th 2023 as an online programme. MUSINGS is envisaged as a weekly programme at 09:00 pm every Wednesday. Thorough the programme we intend to cover topics that are of relevance to surgeons and doctors, but are not conventional surgical topics usually discussed in scientific forum. Over the last 18 weeks we have been able to bring eighteen speakers from various walks of life including surgeons, layers, economists, pilots and literary figures from various parts of the country to talk to us on various topics ranging from retirement plan to legal issues to financial planning for surgeons. We intend to include talks on life stye, hobbies, history, travel etc. in this weekly programme in the coming weeks.
- b. BREASTATHON 2023 -- ASI Kerala State Chapter decided to come up with a novel programme called BREASTATHON 2023 during the month of October this year. The aim of the programme was to generate awareness about breast cancer among the public and to highlight the significance of early diagnosis and surgical treatment to the public. We decided to come together, join hands and operate on breast cancer patients on Saturday 28th October 2023. The idea was that it will put across a strong message to the society that we, the surgical fraternity of the state, stand united in our fight against breast cancer. All surgical centres in the state were requested to join the initiative and an online campaign was initiated. We were able to bring together all like-minded institutes and surgical centres in the state for this common and noble cause. Forty-four centres, including medical colleges, cancer centres and corporate

hospitals participated in this programme on 28th October 2023 by operating on breast cancer cases on that day. We were able to operate on 110 breast cancer cases on the day across the state which brought in publicity to the state chapter and highlighted the significance of surgery in breast cancer among the public. The programme was well covered by the print and visual media.

c. THE TEACHERS OF THE FUTURE -- Conventionally we do have competition based on case presentations, judged by senior post graduate teachers. But the teachers of the future has a format where both the roles are played by the students. The format of the programme is such that a team of postgraduates form a particular college presents the case and another team of students from another college sits as examiners and vice versa. The session would be chaired and judged by a team of senior teachers. The judging was done not only based on the ability to present case and answer questions pertaining to their case but also based on the ability to ask questions and carry forward the discussion when they were assigned the role of teachers during the case presentation of the other team. The programme was initiated this year by the state chapter and 16 teaching institutes took par tin the competition. After the preliminary rounds in which the teams contested among themselves, two finalists were selected. The final round was held during the annual conference and the best team was selected and awarded. The final was witnessed by our nation president Dr Sanjay Kumar Jain and he opined that it was a unique initiative to be emulated by other states. He also congratulated the state chapter for the out of the box thinking and hoped that it would continue next year as well. The state chapter has decided to make it an annual event and name it in the honour of Prof M N Sasikumar who expired in June 2023, who was one of the brains behind the programme when he was the head of the department of medical college Kottayam.
